Color Coding by Event Type	In this latest release, you have the option of color coding items on the calendar by event type. When a color is assigned to an event type, events labeled with it are marked with a small colored square for at-a-glance identification.
Time Zone Display	When entering an event's start and end time, you can also specify the corresponding time zone, which is then displayed next to the time to eliminate any confusion on the part of calendar viewers.
Enhanced Search Capability	Visitors can now use the Keyword search function to find Special Dates and can also search for contact names.
Links to Other Applications	Integrating the EMS Master Calendar with other systems has never been easier. Create your own URL types with custom icons to provide links to other applications such as ticketing, registration, mapping and more. You can even control how prominent these links are – whether they appear right on the main calendar page or only once someone has drilled into an event's details.
Even Tighter Integration with EMS	EMS Master Calendar now has even tighter integration with our room scheduling products, including the ability to import holidays and User Defined Fields, the ability to pull room notes from EMS and more.
Full Year Print Option	The system now gives you the ability to print a full year of monthly calendars in Grid View in one operation.
Actions from Tooltips	Set a reminder, add an event to your personal calendar and more directly from the "tooltip" that is displayed when you hover the cursor over an event on the calendar!
